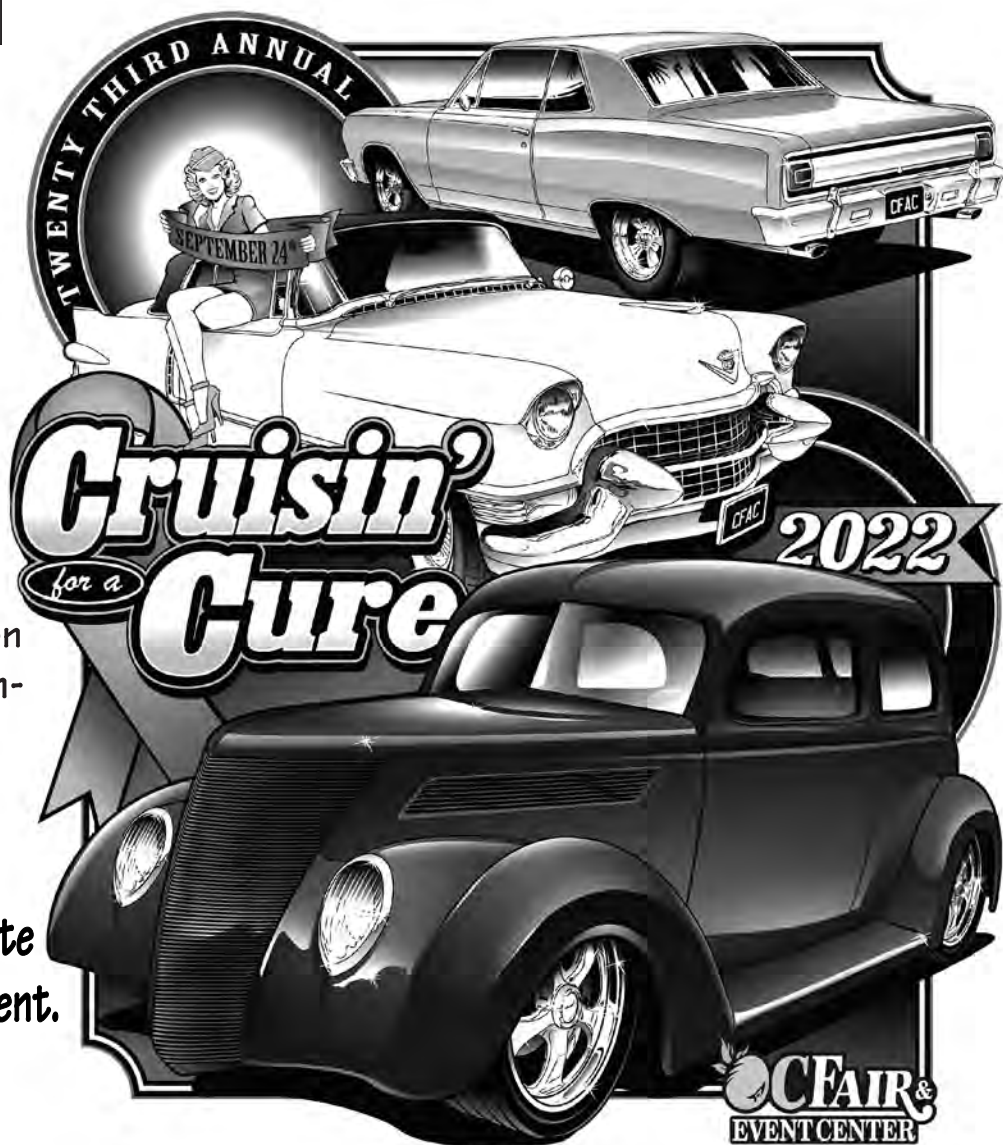

We reserve the right to adjust categories and correct or move entries when necessary. Please ask for help if unsure of the correct category for your entry.

1. Hot Rod / Street Machine - Any Hot Rod or Street Machine.
Must Be Street Legal.
2. Competition, Drag / Straight Line - Includes LSR Vehicles.
3. Competition, Road / Oval Course - Also includes Dirt Racing Vehicles.
4. Custom / Lowrider - Includes Concept Cars and Movie/TV Vehicles.
5. Factory Stock / Replica - Replicas require documetation.
6. Trucks - Any Truck, Van or Tractor, All Scales.
7. Motorcycles - Any Motorcycle, All Scales.
8. Curbside - Any Vehicle. No opened Doors, Hoods, Trunks etc.
9. Small Scale - Any Vehicle, 1/32 Scale or Smaller.
10. Large Scale - Any Vehicle, 1/19 Scale or Larger.
11. Out Of The Box - Any Vehicle Built Only From the Kit Parts - No Modifications.
Decals Other than came in Kit are Allowed. Foil and Paint Techniques and Flocking are Allowed. No Added Wiring, P/E etc.
ENTRY MUST INCLUDE INSTRUCTION SHEET.
12. Modified Die-Cast - Any Vehicle made from a Die-Cast Subject. Includes
Hot Wheels, Action, Danbury, Burago, Classic Metal, etc.
13. Juniors 15 and under - **WORK MUST HAVE BEEN PERFORMED BY ENTRANT.**
Juniors may enter in any of the above classes too.
